# WHEN AND HOW YOU SHALL PAY THE ELECTRICITY BILL? 

You are obliged to pay the monthly bill for electricity consumption not later than 30 days from the date of issuing the latest bill. After this 30-day deadline, you are obliged to pay an overdue payment equal with $0.1 \%$ of the amount of the invoice for each day of delay, but not later than the total value of the invoice itself.
If you do not pay the electricity bill, within 30 days from the deadline, the supplier shall have the right to terminate the supply with electricity.
You have the right to select the payment approach through the supplier's office, through the banks, postal offices, or through direct payment from bank accounts.
All the executed payments shall contain the data such as;

- the number of the bank transfer,
- the number of the bank account and all the data performed on the electricity bill,
- specifically the number of the contract,
- the number of the bill and your name.

The electricity bills shall be sent on your address defined on the contract and if you decide to change your residence without notification, then you are responsible for the non-payments of electricity invoices.
